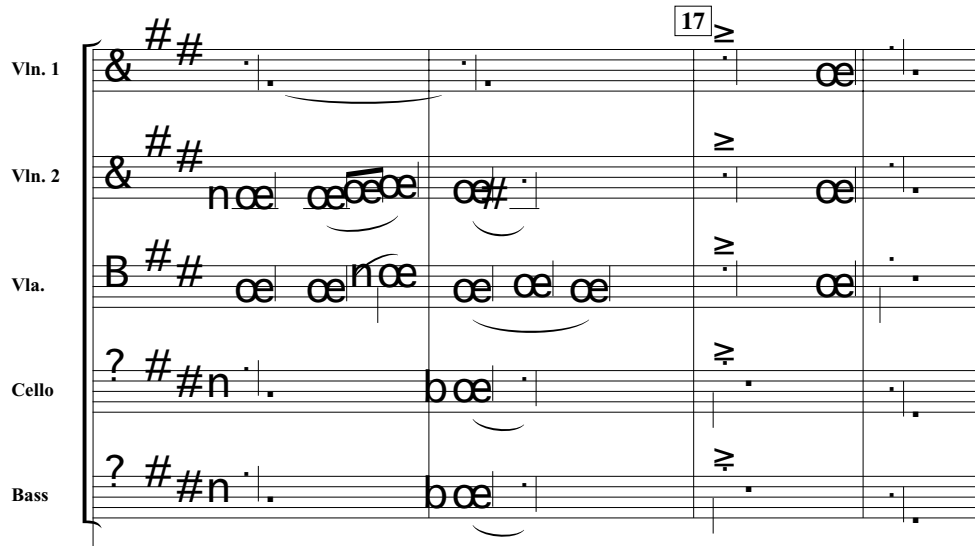
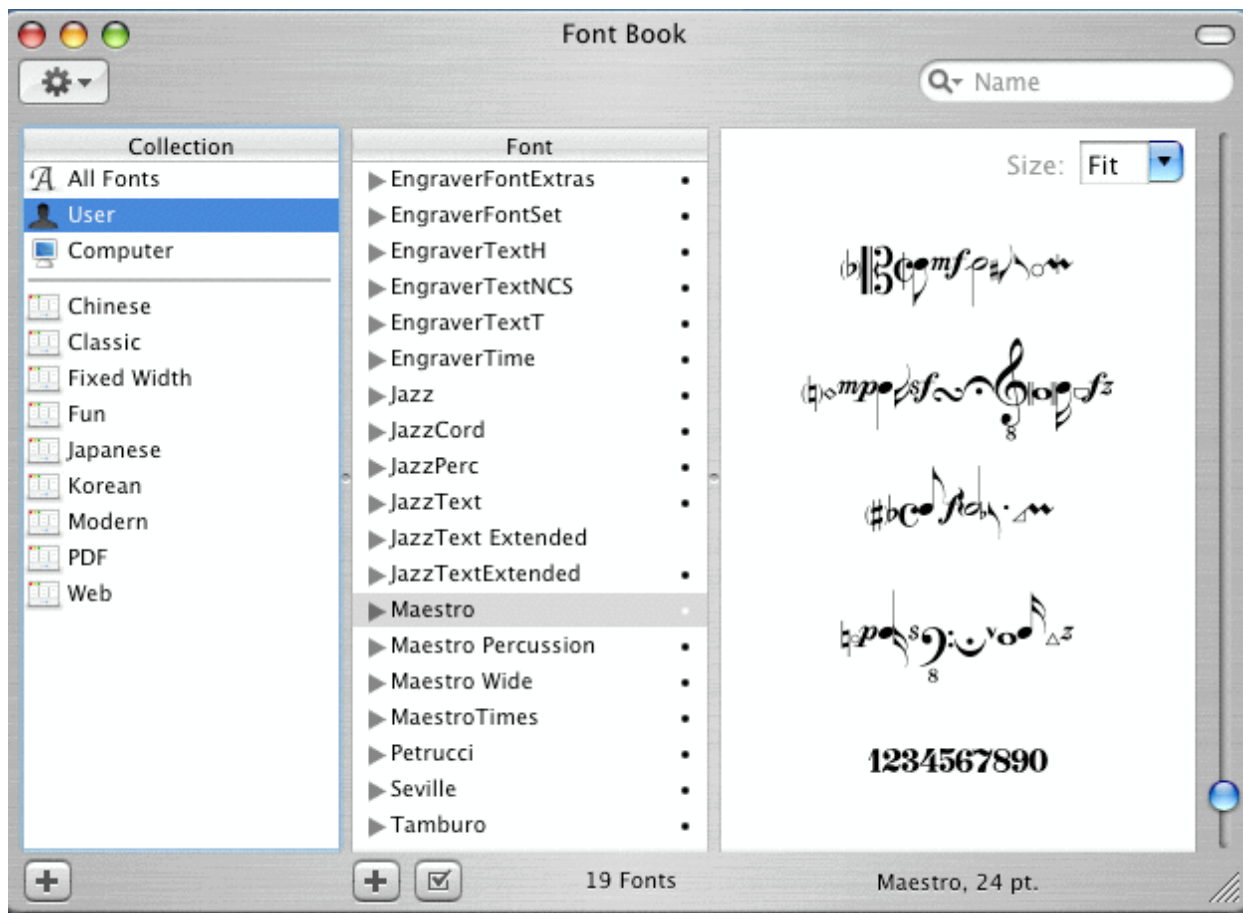


Finale Font Display Problems in Mac OSX



Failure of Finale's fonts to display properly can be caused by missing fonts or a corrupted font cache.

Finale installs fonts in your User Folder > Library > Fonts. To check on proper installation of fonts, open the Apple Font Book application. A full installation of Finale fonts will include the following (check to make sure no fonts are labelled "Off"):



To reinstall missing fonts, use the Finale Font Pack available at:

Alternatively, use your install disc and do a custom install of fonts only.

Cleaning the Font Cache

If the Finale font installation checks out OK, the display problem is probably due to a corrupted font cache.

Here are a few well known utilities that are handy to have available for cleaning caches and for various other Mac maintenance tasks.

Cleaning caches calls for a restart upon completion.

A great utility for managing fonts. Keeps most of your fonts inactive until you need them at which time they'll auto-activate. Great way to keep font lists small.
